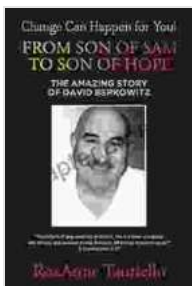

The Early Years

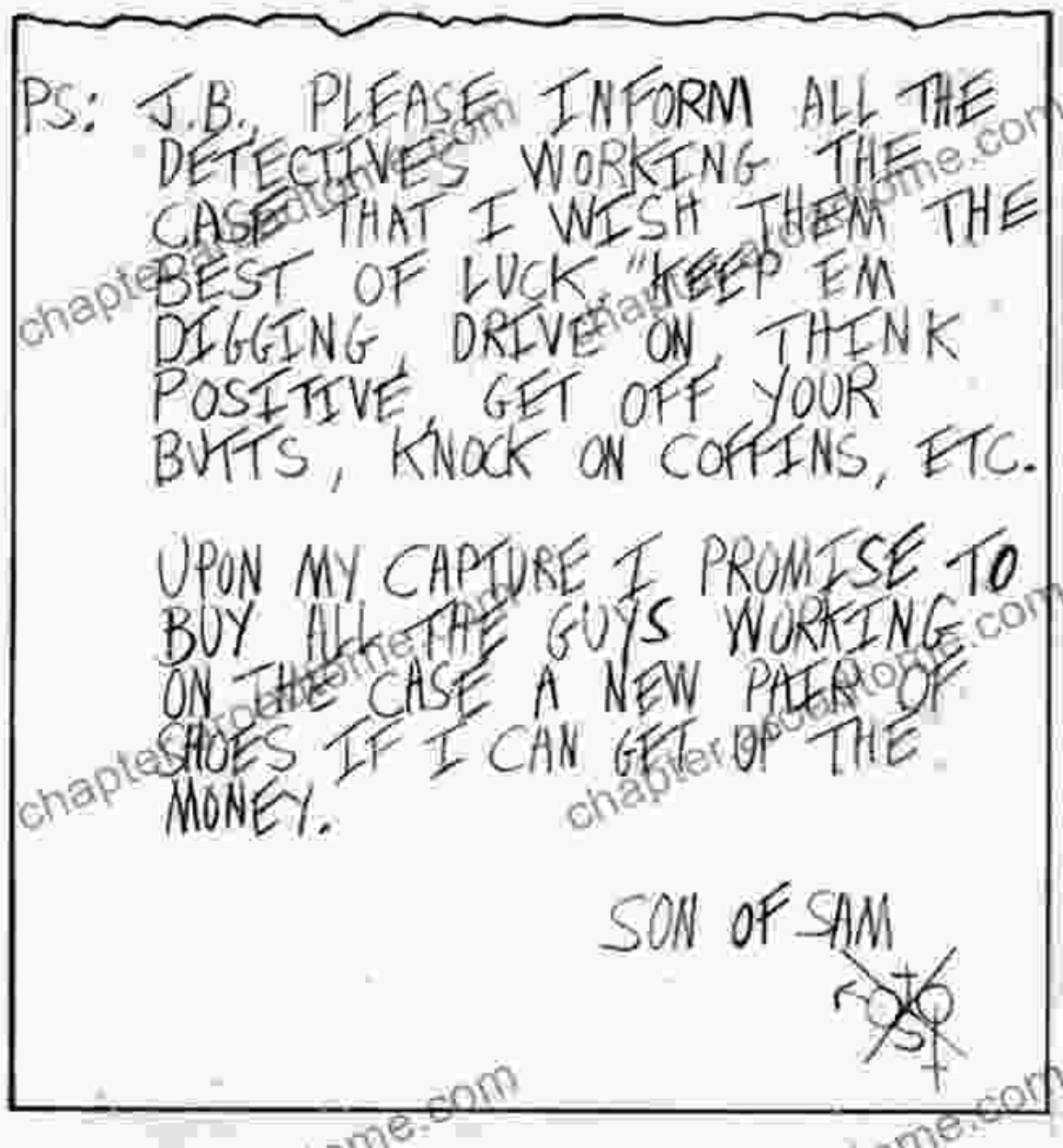

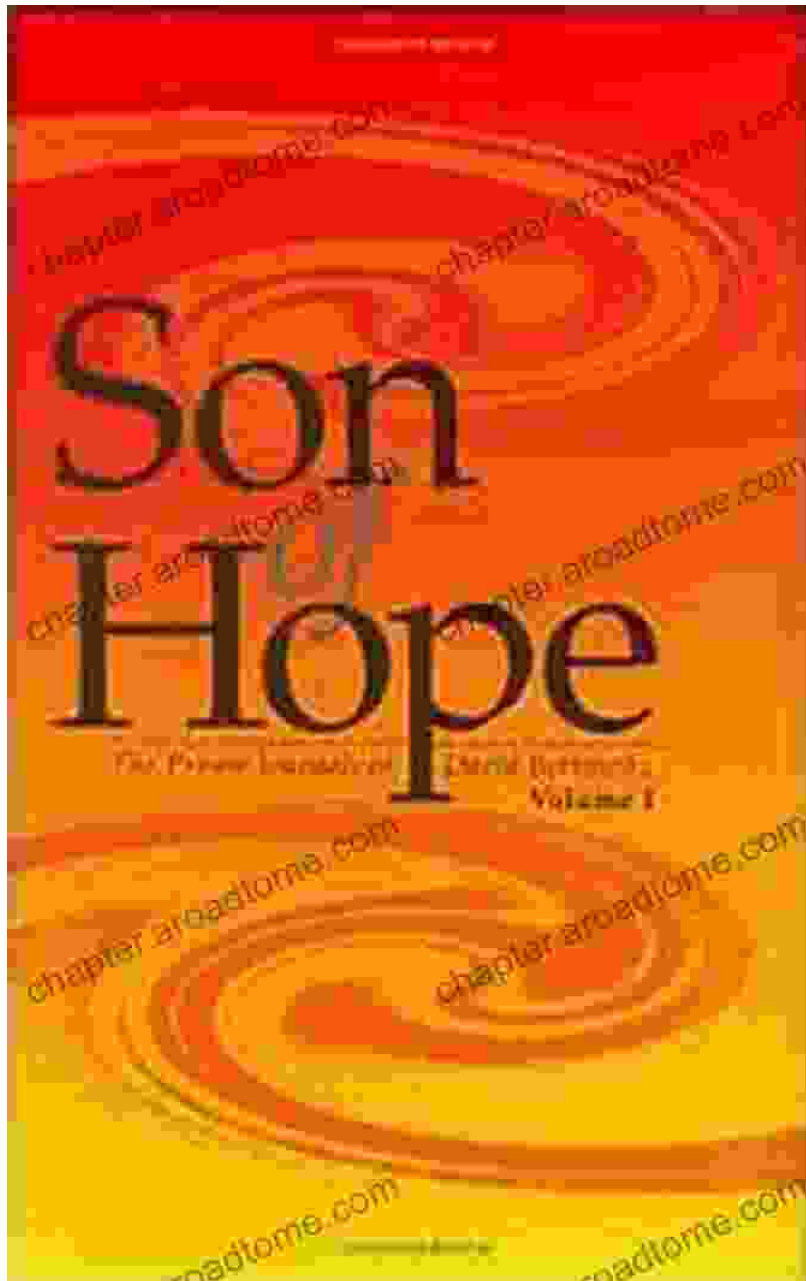

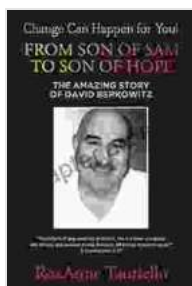
